TO GET THERE

This course is designed for professionals in supervisory roles or with transversal responsibilities in healthcare, social or welfare facilities who do not have a management degree. It is aimed in particular at healthcare professionals in nursing, medico-technical fields, rehabilitation and midwifery.

ACQUIRED SKILLS

The aim of the course is to develop the skills needed to supervise and manage units in health, social or medico-social facilities.

These skills cover both management and the legal and regulatory requirements of careers in health and the healthcare and social welfare sector.

YOUR FUTURE CAREER

At the end of the course, graduates hold managerial positions in healthcare, social or welfare facilities.

Students who achieve more than 14/20 in the dissertation and have at least three years of experience in team management can apply for the "Health, Healthcare and Social Welfare and Treatment Pathways" programme of the second-year Social and Solidarity Economy Master's, in partnership with the Ile-de-France Institute of Service Engineering of Université Gustave Eiffel.

BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM

The course equips professionals without a management degree with the necessary skills to manage units in the healthcare and/or welfare sector. Teaching is provided by academics and professionals.
