TO GET THERE

Students can be admitted to L2 after completing L1 in French Language, Literature and Humanities or a year of preparatory class in literature. Students can be admitted to L2 after completing a high school diploma plus another diploma equivalent to one year of higher education (subject to deliberation by the selection committee).

Students can be admitted to L3 after completing L2 in French Language, Literature and Humanities or two years of preparatory class in literature. Students can be admitted to L3 after completing a high school diploma plus another diploma equivalent to two years of higher education (subject to deliberation by the selection committee).

Expected skills and knowledge: good level of written and oral expression in French, literary knowledge, interest in technology, creativity, curiosity and open-mindedness.

ACQUIRED SKILLS

Writing in different contexts and formats (print, digital); proficiency in written and oral French; ability to use various software used in writing-related professions; excellent literary knowledge; ability to analyse text and image; ability to express yourself in writing and orally in a foreign language (English); developed creativity; creation of career plan; working in a team and in project mode.

YOUR FUTURE CAREER

We advise that students continue their training with a Master's to become specialised. At our university, the following courses are offered:

- Master's in Print and Digital Book Publishing
 - Master's in Literature, Knowledge and Digital Culture
 - Master's in Web Careers and Cultures
 - Master's in Corporate Communication and Social Media
- Outside of our university: Master's in literary creation; journalism school, etc.

BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM

The Licence degree in Literature, Creation and Digital Technology is a pioneering degree that combines literary culture, digital culture, pedagogical innovation and professional experience. The core modules provide students with the methodological foundations of the discipline (conceptual and textual analysis through essay and commentary exercises, oral presentations on summary questions, etc.). Specialisation subjects are taught by industry professionals, to provide useful skills for careers in publishing, books and writing. Advantages of the course: - work-study format possible in L3; - work placements and tutored projects with major companies; - project-based pedagogy (book mock-ups, websites, etc.); - emphasis placed on creativity and different forms of writing; - an introduction to various digital tools (InDesign, WordPress, etc.); - emphasis placed on modern language classes, included in the curriculum; - a high level of support for students.
