TO GET THERE

Open to applicants in initial training, vocational training, or Validation of Acquired Experience (VAE). Students must have completed a general Licence degree (preferably a Licence in Foreign and Regional Languages, Literature and Civilisations in English) or an M1 or M2 in Research in English.

Students may also be admitted on the basis of studies completed overseas, which must be approved (C2 level in French for English-speaking students).

ACQUIRED SKILLS

The course includes three complementary focal points: discipline-specific training, theoretical professional training and practical professional training. The discipline-specific classes prepare students for the CAPES exam: literature, civilisation, written and oral language, and theoretical and practical professional knowledge. Students undertake a work placement as early as M1. This experience is deepened and extended in M2 when they write a discipline-specific, professional thesis.

YOUR FUTURE CAREER

The main job opportunities are roles in teaching, particularly English secondary teaching: students who pass the CAPES exam and graduate from the Master's in Careers in Teaching, Education and Training can work as certified English teachers in middle and high schools. Students who graduate from the Master's - but do not pass the CAPES - can work as contractual secondary teachers.

BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM

Students prepare for the teaching exam through regular training sessions, both written and oral. The work placements in M1 and M2 represent true preparation for the challenges of working as a teacher. This experience is enriched and extended through the reflexive work needed to write a thesis in M2. The course truly prepares students to enter the professional world.
