TO GET THERE

Students must have earned 120 ECTS or equivalent within the framework of a Licence degree, Technical University Diploma or Advanced Vocational Training Certificate in Economics, Management or Social Sciences. The programme is in English, and requires a minimum B2 level (4 skills) and, for foreign students, a B1 level in French is preferable.

ACQUIRED SKILLS

Acquiring general skills: autonomy, university work methods, the ability to analyse and summarise, written and oral expression and cross-cultural interpersonal skills. Preprofessional skills: understanding of the socio-economic sector, personal and career plan, contextualisation of acquired knowledge. Specific skills in management and quantitative methods.

YOUR FUTURE CAREER

Students with a Licence degree can try to enter the international job market or have a number of options for continuing their studies if they wish to become senior executives:

- Pursue their studies in one of IAE's specialisations,
- Pursue their studies abroad,
- Enrol at another university or business school.

BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM

The programme is taught in English and is open to both French and foreign students. French students study abroad in the second semester and foreign students complete a work placement. Second foreign language or French as a foreign language compulsory. IAE-accredited.
