This professional Licence degree is designed for students who have completed two years of higher education (economics, literature, communication) or a course at a applied arts school, engineering and material culture school, decorative arts school or fine arts school.

Three statutes are accepted: apprenticeship, lifelong learning and a professionalisation contract.

ACQUIRED SKILLS

Working in a professional environment requires not only professional skills but also creative abilities based on an inquiring mind, a strong artistic sensibility, knowledge general and technological culture, the creative design method and approach through proficient use of practical and theoretical tools, the ability to work in a team, discussing and communicating skills, the ability to identify social issues, step back, find a position and gain perspective, and an outward-looking international perspective.

YOUR FUTURE CAREER

At the end of this professional Licence, graduates can aspire to the following jobs:

- Freelance designer
- Industrial designer employed by or working with a specialist multidisciplinary design agency.
- Independent industrial designer, consultant to industrial or service companies and design agencies.

Students can also work for communication, volume or packaging consultancies, design studios, design departments in a company or design offices; design agencies; packaging manufacturers; graphic industry companies.
